- 1. Students of classes VI to VIII can participate and it is an individual event.
- 2. Reporting time will be 9 a.m. on 15th October and venue will be Guru Nanak Matriculation Higher Secondary School.
- 3. Students must come in school uniform mandatorily and wear ID card.
- 4. Chart paper A2 size will be provided on the spot.
- 5. Name and School name will not be written in the chart provided. Posters will be identified by the Lot numbers and provided on the spot.
- 6. Students need to bring their own individual stationery and colouring materials to avoid sharing.
- 7. One-hour duration will be given for drawing and colouring the poster.
- 8. Poster can depict images relevant to the topic/theme on conveying the message but not image of any of the Sikh Gurus.
- 9. Should not have religious drawing that hurts the sentiment of the community.
- 10. Creative way of portraying the topic is encouraged.
- 11. No extra time will be given.
- 12. Posters will be judged based on relevance to the theme, originality, artistic composition, creativity, message conveyed by the poster and effectiveness in communicating the intended message.
- 13. Judge's decision will be final.
- 14. 3 Prizes and 5 consolation prizes will be awarded for the winners.

PODCAST

"The podcast content may engage with multiple sub-themes, centered on the overall topic."

1. Eligibility: Open to School Students (Classes 9–12) and College Students (UG & PG) in and around Tamil Nadu.

2. Team Formation:

- Each team may consist of 2-5 members per team (maximum 5).
- Roles may include performers, presenters, directors and Editors for a holistic podcast presentation.
- The number of teams per institution is not restricted.

3. Format & Performance

This is an online competition, Podcast presentations must be audio/video recorded and submitted online. Shortlisted finalists will perform live on the day of the competition.

- Duration: 3-5 minutes per team.
- Language: Tamil or English.

- Content must be clean, respectful, and appropriate.
- Strictly prohibited: double meanings, offensive/obscene language or actions. or political views will lead to disqualification

4. Presentation Style

Podcasts can be expressed creatively through a blend of multiple formats, such as:

- Storytelling
- Poetry recitation
- Conversation / Dialogue
- Quiz or Q&A
- Narration / Panel discussion
- Musical story telling.
- Any other innovative forms of expression

A mix of formats and variety in the given time is encouraged

5. Originality

- All content must be the team's original creation.
- Plagiarism, copied content, or use of AI-generated scripts/voices will lead to disqualification.

6. Submission

- Deadline: 9th October 2025, 1:00 PM.
- Each team must submit:
- Final audio/video file (max size: 1.5 GB) uploaded via the Google Form.
- Provide the Google Drive link of the file (ensure Editor access is enabled).
- One entry per team. Late submissions will not be considered.

7. Final Round

- Selected finalists will perform live on stage before the jury.
- School teams (Classes 9–12) must be accompanied by a teacher.

8. Judging Criteria

- Content: Depth, relevance, and authenticity.
- Creativity: Originality, style, and innovative use of formats.
- Performance: Clarity, teamwork, and audience engagement.

9. Prize

• The prize will be awarded to the entire team (team prize)

10. Final Decision

• The jury's decision will be final and binding.
